The meeting was opened by Chief Carpenter welcoming everyone and giving a brief history of how this committee was formed and what the overall goal of the committee was.

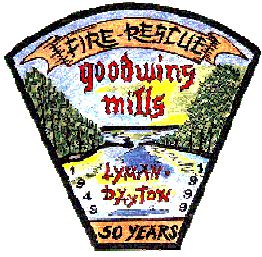
General discussions were held on how to attack the tasks that this committee is set out to do.
